Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Our company has been notified that the tipping fee in Lewis County will increase from \$90.00 to \$100.00 per ton, an 11.1% increase, effective February 1, 2022. With this filing we are proposing to increase residential and commercial rates. The drop box pass-through disposal increase was previously filed and docketed as TG-220027. We project this will increase revenue for residential service by \$100,300, 3.97%, and for commercial service by \$94,400 for a 12-month period. There are approximately 12,000 residential, 1,700 commercial customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by the Commission was effective September 1, 2020.

Attached are the tariff pages as well as supporting documentation containing the rate increase rate calculations. Please note customer counts and tonnage reviewed and approved in TG-200682 were used in this filing.

If approved by the Commission, the rates will become effective March 1, 2022. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
