Enclosed, please find revised pages 2, 21, 23, 24, 29, 30, 32, and 33 to the above-referenced tariff. These proposed revised tariff pages contain increased rates for residential and commercial garbage collection services. The requested rate increase is necessary to comply with the Kittitas County Resolution No. 2022-160 passed by the Kittitas County Board of Commissioners on August 16, 2022. This resolution reflects an increase in disposal fees from \$121.63 to \$133.79 to become effective on November 1, 2022. The increased rates, if approved by the commission, would increase Company revenue by approximately \$71,000, and residential and commercial garbage rates by 4.9%. The requested effective date of the proposed tariff revisions is November 1, 2022.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting workpapers and Resolution No. 2022-160. Upon approval by the Commission, affected customers will be notified of this rate change on their next regularly scheduled billing.
