On April 12[,] 2024 Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), filed its proposed modifications to its electric tariff Schedule 65, "Interconnection Standards", to align the processes for interconnecting generating facilities (other than net metering systems) subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission with the processes provided under Avista's Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT). It was brought to Avista's attention that a broken link was provided on First Revision Sheet 65 included in the Company's original filing. Avista submits a corrected link in Substitute First Revision Sheet 65.
