Thank you for filing Clark County's 2023 – 2028 Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan.

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has completed its review of preliminary draft of the Lewis County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan Update (Plan).

The 2023-2028 Plan proposes to increase tip fees in 2024 by 5.27 percent and for years 2025-2028 by approximately 3.5 percent each year to keep up with inflation. As a result, there will be a minimal rate impact to ratepayers served by regulated solid waste collection companies in Clark County.
