DECLARATION OF KATHRYN
MCPHERSON

I, Kathryn McPherson, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington, declare as follows:

1. I am over 18 years of age and competent to testify to the facts contained herein.
2. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a compliance investigator in the Transportation Safety Division. As a compliance investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations into the operations of regulated and unregulated transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate charter party or excursion services carriers that may be operating without the required Commission-issued certificate.
3. On October 31, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) initiated an investigation of High Society Transportation LLC (High Society or Company) to determine if the Company was operating as a charter and excursion carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining a certificate.
4. October 31, 2019, Staff discovered High Society was registered with the Secretary of State's office showing the owner listed as Brandon Scott Russell. The Company's Unified Business Identifier (UBI) number is 604-017-131, with an official mailing address of 302 W 5th Street, Unit B, Cle Elum, Washington 98922.¹
5. On October 31, 2019, Staff sent High Society a non-compliance letter to the owner of record, Brandon Russell, at 302 W 5th St. Unit A, Cle Elum, Washington 98922.² The letter provides technical assistance regarding the requirement to have a charter and excursion certificate and directs the Company to cease and desist all operations until High Society obtains authority from the Commission.
6. On November 13, 2019, Staff spoke with the Company. High Society acknowledged receipt of the non-compliance letter and received technical assistance.³

7. On November 19, 2019, the Commission received an application for charter party and excursion carrier services.⁴
8. On March 9, 2020, the Commission notified the High Society by letter in Docket TE-190966 that the application for charter and excursion authority was dismissed because High Society did not provide a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) from the insurance company.⁵
9. On October 22, 2020, Staff closed the investigation, as the Company's Facebook and website were no longer active.
10. On August 4, 2021, Staff re-opened an investigation of High Society after case follow-up. The follow-up showed the Company had advertisements on Facebook in violation of Commission rules.⁶
11. On August 4, 2021, Staff communicated with High Society via Facebook messenger. The Company provided an offer for services that require a certificate.⁷
12. On August 12, 2021, Staff requested a docket for the investigation of High Society. Docket TE-210619 requested determination if the Company was in violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.70.220.
13. On November 15, 2021, the Company was served Order 01, Instituting Special Proceeding, Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties, Notice of Virtual Hearing.⁸
14. On December 7, 2021, the Commission entered Order 02.⁹ High Society was classified as a charter party or excursion services carrier, ordered to cease and desist operations without first obtaining a certificate, and assessed a penalty of \$10,000. The Commission suspended a \$9,000 portion of the penalty for two years to be waived thereafter if the Company complied with stipulations. The Company was required to pay the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in accordance with a payment schedule.
15. On August 1, 2022, High Society completed all payments due to the Commission.¹⁰
16. On January 8, 2025, Staff reviewed outstanding compliance items for closure. As standard procedure, Staff reviewed Company activities. High Society had an active UBI number with the Department of Revenue, 604-017-131, with no limousine endorsement.¹¹

17. On January 8, 2025, Staff reviewed advertisements for High Society. Staff found High Society's Facebook page, offering limousine, luxury sedan, and party bus services.¹²
18. On January 8, 2025, Staff reviewed advertisements for High Society. Staff found advertisements on Yelp offering Limos, Airport Shuttles, and Wine Tours.¹³
19. On January 8, 2025, Staff reviewed advertisements online and found two separate advertisements. High Society has an advertisement on Cle Elum Community Page.¹⁴ Additionally, Staff found advertisements for the Company on www.allseasonsvacationrents.com for shuttle and limo services.¹⁵
20. On January 8, 2025, using a fictitious name, Staff sent a request for services via Facebook messenger to the Company's page. Staff received an offer of service to transport up to 9 people for \$150 each way.¹⁶
21. On January 29, 2025, Staff researched Department of Licensing vehicle registrations and found the company has two vehicles registered for High Society, a 2006 Limousine Bus, plate number BIE1523, and a 2000 Lincoln Towncar, plate number C35127H.¹⁷
22. Based on paragraphs 16 through 20 above, Commission staff finds that High Society is operating as a charter party or excursion services carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate from the Commission.

Dear Mr. Russell:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) believes that you are providing passenger transportation services that require charter and excursion authority from the Commission. The purpose of this letter is to learn more about the passenger transportation services your company offers and to provide technical assistance with respect to Washington's passenger transportation licensing requirements.

As defined in WAC 480-30-036, one or more of the vehicles advertised and operated by your company requires a charter and excursion certificate from the Commission. Any company that operates a "vehicle with a manufacturer's seating capacity for eight or more passengers, including the driver, used on the public highways, for the transportation of persons for compensation," requires a charter and excursion certificate from the Commission.

Commission records show that you have not obtained the **required** certificate to operate as a charter and excursion carrier. Providing these services without a certificate is illegal, considered a gross misdemeanor, and punishable as defined in RCW 81.70.220 and WAC 480-30-246. Each violation of RCW 81.70.220 is subject to a penalty of up to \$5,000 per violation.

To avoid enforcement action by the Commission, no later than November 15, 2019, please do one of the following:

- Submit a completed application, file proof of insurance, and include the application fee to the Commission. For questions about the application process, please contact our Licensing Services staff at (360) 664-1222



INTRODUCTION

- 1 The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), pursuant to RCW 81.04.510, institutes this special proceeding on its own motion to determine whether High Society Transportation LLC (High Society Transportation or Company) has engaged, and is engaging, in unlawful operations without a charter party and excursion service carrier certificate in violation of RCW 81.70.220.
- 2 The Commission has information from which it believes and therefore alleges that High Society Transportation has advertised, solicited, offered, or entered into one or more agreements to provide charter party or excursion carrier service within the state of Washington without having first obtained a charter party and excursion service carrier certificate.
- 3 Pursuant to RCW 81.04.510, upon proof of these allegations, the Commission is authorized to issue an order requiring High Society Transportation to cease and desist activities subject to regulation under Title 81 RCW. In addition, RCW 81.04.110 authorizes the Commission to file a complaint on its own motion setting forth any act or omission by High Society Transportation that violates any law, or any order or rule of the Commission. The Commission may impose financial penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.
- 4 At the hearing in this special proceeding that will be conducted pursuant to Part IV of the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), RCW 34.05, of which notice is given here, the Commission will also consider its Complaint against High Society Transportation

alleging violations of law as specified below and will decide whether High Society Transportation should be penalized.

ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

- 5 The Commission has jurisdiction to institute a special proceeding to determine whether High Society Transportation is conducting business requiring operating authority, or has performed or is performing any act requiring Commission approval without securing such approval pursuant to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.01.010, and RCW 81.04.510. In addition to the foregoing statutes, this matter involves Title 81 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 81.04.020 and RCW 81.70.220. This matter also involves the administrative rules set forth in WAC 480-30 and WAC 480-07.
- 6 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS that High Society Transportation appear virtually before the Commission in this special proceeding conducted under the authority of RCW 81.04.510 at 9:30 a.m., on December 7, 2021,** to give testimony and evidence under oath as to its operations. The burden of proving that the alleged operations are not subject to the provisions of Title 81 RCW shall be upon High Society Transportation, as provided by RCW 81.04.510.

COMPLAINT SEEKING PENALTIES

PARTIES

- 11 Complainant, the Commission, is an agency of the state of Washington, authorized by state law to regulate the rates, services, facilities, and practices of public service companies, including charter party or excursion service carriers, under the provisions of Title 81 RCW.
- 12 Respondent, High Society Transportation, is a charter party or excursion service carrier that does business in the state of Washington.

JURISDICTION

- 13 The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.04.110, RCW 81.01.010, RCW 81.04.160, RCW 81.04.460, and RCW 81.70.

BACKGROUND

- 14 According to the Declaration of the Commission compliance investigator, presented to the undersigned administrative law judge¹ under penalty of perjury, the following facts establish probable cause for the Commission to complain against the activities of High Society Transportation and to seek penalties in accordance with applicable law.
- 15 On or about August 4, 2021, High Society Transportation offered to provide charter party or excursion carrier service without first having obtained a certificate from the Commission.
- 16 According to evidence obtained from the Company's Facebook page, www.facebook.com/highsocietytransportationllc, High Society Transportation has been operating as a charter party carrier or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington without a certificate.

APPLICABLE LAW AND REGULATION

- 17 Under state law, the definition of "charter party carrier" includes every person "engaged in the transportation over any public highways in this state of a group of persons who, pursuant to a common purpose and under a single contract, acquire the use of a motor vehicle to travel together as a group to a specified destination or for a particular itinerary, either agreed upon in advance or modified by the chartered group after leaving the place of origin." RCW 81.70.020(1).
- 18 Under state law, the definition of charter party carrier includes a person who "advertises, solicits, offers, or enters into an agreement to carry passengers over any public highway within the state of Washington." RCW 81.70.220(1).
- 19 The term "person" can mean a corporation or firm as well as an individual. RCW 81.70.020(9). Specifically included in this term are individuals, firms, corporations, associations, partnerships, lessees, receivers, trustees, consortiums, joint venture, or commercial entities. WAC 480-30-036.
- 20 The term "charter party carrier" or "charter carrier" means every person engaged in the transportation over any public highways in this state of a group of persons who, pursuant

to a common purpose and under a single contract, acquire the use of a motor vehicle to travel together as a group to a specified destination or for a particular itinerary, either agreed upon in advance or modified by the chartering group after leaving the place of origin. A person who is engaged in the transportation of persons by party bus over any public highway in this state is considered engaging in the business of a charter party carrier or excursion service carrier. WAC 480-30-036.

- 21 Charter party and excursion service carriers are common carriers. RCW 81.04.010(11). For the purposes of Title 81 RCW, every common carrier is a public service company. RCW 81.04.010.
- 22 It is illegal to engage in business as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington without having first obtained a certificate from the Commission. RCW 81.70.220(1).
- 23 Any person who engages in business as a charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington without having first obtained a certificate from the Commission is subject to a penalty of up to \$5,000 per violation. RCW 81.70.220(2). If the basis for the violation is advertising, each advertisement reproduced, broadcast, or displayed via a particular medium constitutes a separate violation. RCW 81.70.220(1).
- 24 The Commission is authorized to file a complaint on its own motion setting forth any act or omission by any public service company that violates any law or any order or rule of the Commission. RCW 81.04.110.

COMPLAINT

- 25 The Commission, through its Staff, re-alleges the statements contained in paragraphs 14 through 24 above.
- 26 High Society Transportation has violated RCW 81.70.220(1) at least once by offering charter party or excursion carrier service to transport passengers without first having obtained a certificate from the Commission.
- 27 High Society Transportation has violated RCW 81.70.220(1) at least once by advertising to transport passengers without first having obtained a certificate from the Commission.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

- 28 Staff requests that the Commission, pursuant to its authority under RCW 81.70.220(2), assess penalties of up to \$5,000 per violation against High Society Transportation. Staff will present testimonial evidence at the hearing to address the factors for determining an appropriate penalty amount. Further, Staff may request that some portion of any penalty actually imposed be suspended for a period of time sufficient to demonstrate High Society Transportation's intent to comply with all applicable laws and rules governing the charter party and excursion service carrier industry.

PROBABLE CAUSE

- 29 Based on a review of the Declaration of the Commission compliance investigator assigned to this matter, and consistent with RCW 80.01.060 and WAC 480-07-307, the Commission finds probable cause exists to issue this Complaint.

NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING

- 30 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE THAT it will conduct a virtual hearing concerning this Complaint concurrently with the special proceeding noticed above, which will commence at 9:30 a.m., on December 7, 2021.**

BACKGROUND

Synopsis. *This is an Administrative Law Judge's Initial Order that is not effective unless approved or allowed to become effective as described in the notice at the end of this Order. This Initial Order is based upon a stipulation presented by the parties. If this Initial Order becomes final, High Society Transportation LLC, (High Society or Company) will be assessed a financial penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for two (2) violations of RCW 81.70.220(1). A \$9,000 portion of the penalty will be suspended for a period of two years from the date of this order, and then waived, subject to the condition that High Society refrains from further operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier without first obtaining the required certificate from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission). In addition, if this Initial Order becomes final, High Society will be classified as a charter party or excursion service carrier and required to permanently cease and desist from operating as a charter party or excursion service carrier without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.*

- 1 **Nature of Proceeding.** The Commission initiated this special proceeding to determine if High Society has engaged, and continues to engage, in business as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington without possessing the certificate required for such operations.
- 2 **Procedural History.** On November 15, 2021, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Virtual Hearing, pursuant to RCW 81.04.510, initiating this docket on its own motion. The Complaint alleges that High Society violated RCW 81.70.220 by:

- (1) offering on at least one occasion to provide charter party or excursion carrier service in the state of Washington, and
- (2) advertising charter party or excursion carrier service within the state of Washington on at least one occasion

without the certificate required for such operations. On the same date, the Commission issued a *Subpoena and Subpoena Duces Tecum For Production of Documents* (Subpoenas) to the Company commanding Brandon Russell, owner of High Society, to appear before the Commission at a special virtual proceeding scheduled to convene at 9:30 a.m. on December 7, 2021, and to provide documents in electronic form in advance of the virtual hearing as specified in the Subpoenas.

3 **Hearing.** On December 7, 2021, the hearing convened virtually as scheduled before Administrative Law Judge Rayne Pearson.

4 **Appearances.** Michael Dotson, Compliance Investigator, Lacey, Washington, represents the Commission's regulatory staff (Commission Staff).¹ Brandon Russell, Cle Elum, Washington, represents the Company, *pro se*.

DISCUSSION

5 **Applicable Law.** RCW 81.70.020(1) defines "charter party carrier" as:

every person engaged in the transportation over any public highways in this state of a group of persons, who, pursuant to a common purpose and under a single contract, acquire the use of a motor vehicle to travel together as a group to a specified destination or for a particular itinerary, either agreed upon in advance or modified by the chartered group after leaving the place of origin.

¹ In adjudications the Commission's regulatory staff participates like any other party, while an administrative law judge or the Commissioners make the decision. To assure fairness, the Commissioners and the presiding administrative law judge do not discuss the merits of the proceeding with regulatory staff or any other party without giving notice and opportunity for all parties to participate. - 6 RCW 81.70.020(5) defines “excursion service carrier” as:
- every person engaged in the transportation of persons for compensation over any public highway in this state from points of origin within the incorporated limits of any city or town or area, to any other location within the state of Washington and returning to that origin.
- 7 RCW 81.70.220(1) defines “engage in the business of a charter party carrier or excursion service carrier” as:
- advertising or soliciting, offering, or entering into an agreement to provide such service.
- 8 RCW 81.70.220(1) prohibits charter party or excursion service carriers from conducting any operations without first having obtained a certificate from the Commission. Upon proof of unauthorized operations, RCW 81.04.510 authorizes the Commission to order the uncertificated company to cease and desist its activities. Additionally, RCW 81.04.110 authorizes the Commission to file a complaint on its own motion setting forth any act or omission by a company that violates any law, order, or rule of the Commission.
- 9 RCW 81.70.220(2) subjects persons who conduct operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier of passengers in violation of RCW 81.70.220(1) a penalty of up to \$5,000 for each violation.
- 10 **Stipulation Presented by Parties.** At hearing, Brandon Russell agreed that High Society has conducted operations in the state of Washington without the required certificate. The Company offered to provide charter party or excursion carrier service on at least one occasion in the state of Washington and also advertised charter party or excursion carrier service in the state of Washington on at least one occasion.
- 11 High Society has agreed to permanently shut down and cease operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier, as defined by RCW 81.70.020, without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.
- 12 Under RCW 81.70.220(2), Commission Staff is authorized to seek a penalty of up to \$10,000 against the Company. Based upon the above-noted stipulation, Commission Staff now seeks to have \$9,000 of the penalty suspended for two years, and then waived, on the conditions that: (1) the Company honors its pledge of future compliance by

permanently staying out of the industry without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission, and (2) High Society pays the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that is not suspended in accordance with the payment schedule in Appendix A.

- 13 The parties agree that the Company's compliance history is a negative factor, making a suspended penalty appropriate as a tool to ensure High Society does not re-enter the charter party or excursion service carrier industry without first obtaining the required certificate.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 14 (1) The Commission is an agency of the state of Washington vested by statute with authority to regulate persons conducting operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier for compensation over public roads in Washington.
- 15 (2) The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding and over High Society.
- 16 (3) On at least one occasion, High Society offered to provide charter party or excursion carrier service without the required certificate from the Commission in violation of RCW 81.70.220(1).
- 17 (4) On at least one occasion, High Society advertised to provide charter party or excursion carrier service without the required certificate from the Commission in violation of RCW 81.70.220(1).

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 18 (1) High Society Transportation LLC is classified as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington.
- 19 (2) High Society Transportation LLC is ordered to immediately cease and desist operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.
- 20 (3) High Society Transportation LLC is assessed a penalty of \$10,000. A \$9,000 portion of the penalty is suspended for a period of two years from the date of this Order, and waived thereafter, provided that: (1) High Society Transportation LLC

refrains permanently from further operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate from the Commission, and (2) High Society Transportation LLC pays the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that is not suspended in accordance with the payment schedule in Appendix A.

- 21 (4) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties to this proceeding to effectuate the terms of this Order.

If you agree with this Initial Order and you would like the Order to become final before the time limits expire, you may send a letter to the Commission waiving your right to petition for administrative review.

WAC 480-07-825(2) provides that any party to this proceeding has twenty (20) days after the entry of this initial order to file a petition for administrative review (Petition). Section (2)(b) of the rule identifies what you must include in any Petition as well as other requirements for a Petition. WAC 480-07-825(2)(c) states that any party may file a response to a Petition within 10 days after service of the Petition.

WAC 480-07-830 provides that before the Commission enters a final order any party may file a petition to reopen a contested proceeding to permit receipt of evidence essential to a decision, but unavailable and not reasonably discoverable with due diligence at the time of hearing, or for other good and sufficient cause. The Commission will give other parties in the proceeding an opportunity to respond to a motion to reopen the record, unless the Commission determines that it can rule on the motion without hearing from the other parties.


