RE: Advice 25-02—PacifiCorp's 2025 Power Cost Only Rate Case

In accordance with RCW 80.28.060 and WAC 480-80-105, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) submits for filing and approval by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) proposed new tariff sheets applicable to electric service supplied by PacifiCorp in the state of Washington to become effective on January 1, 2026. The new proposed tariff sheets are contained in Exhibit No. ATL-3 accompanying this filing. In accordance with WAC 480-07-510(2), the proposed new tariff sheets are also provided in legislative format.

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Purpose of the 2025 Power Cost Only Rate Case

The rate year one baseline level of net power costs embedded in PacifiCorp's electric rates was established through the Commission's final order approving PacifiCorp's 2023 general rate case in Docket No. UE-230172. Order 09 in that same proceeding also required PacifiCorp to submit a power cost only rate case (PCORC) that will reset the baseline to remove coal-fired resources from rates.

PacifiCorp's 2025 PCORC reflects an increase in revenues of approximately \$33.9 million, or 7.9 percent relative to the present revenue level requested by PacifiCorp in its rate year two compliance filing. All rate schedules for electric service are affected by the change. A typical residential customer using 1,200 kilowatt-hours per month will see an increase of \$10.43 per month.

Testimony

Accompanying this filing are the testimony and exhibits of witnesses Joelle R. Steward, Rick T. Link, Ramon J. Mitchell, Isaiah M. R. Zacharia and Daniel J. MacNeil, Sherona L. Cheung, Michael G. Wilding, Rohini Ghosh, and André T. Lipinski. Together, these testimonies describe the elements of this filing and the essential changes that are being proposed.

PacifiCorp has marked certain pages of its filing "DESIGNATED INFORMATION IS CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160." These documents are protected from any further disclosure by the Commission or the Office of the Attorney General, including their outside experts, under RCW 80.04.095 and WAC 480-07-160.

PacifiCorp requests that the documents contained in the envelopes identified with the cover page marked "DESIGNATED INFORMATION IS CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160," as well as the files marked "CONFIDENTIAL" or "CONF" on the versions containing confidential materials, be treated as confidential under the provisions of WAC 480-07-160 because they contain sensitive commercial information. In accordance with WAC 480-07-160(5), PacifiCorp has enclosed redacted versions of the documents containing confidential information along with the non-confidential documents in its filing, and has placed unredacted versions of the documents containing confidential information in separate envelopes with corresponding "DESIGNATED INFORMATION IS CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160" labels on the envelopes. Each page of the unredacted version containing confidential information is printed on yellow paper.

Certain confidential workpapers have been designated confidential in their entirety per WAC 480-07-160(8). These workpapers are large and complex excel spreadsheets that would be either impractical or unduly burdensome to mark as required under WAC 480-07-160(4) through (7).

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Notice of the PCORC

The tariff sheets included in this filing reflect an issue date of April 1, 2025, with an effective date of January 1, 2026. In compliance with WAC 480-100-194, PacifiCorp agrees to suspend the proposed tariff filing and thus is not required to publish notice immediately before or coincident with the date of this filing. PacifiCorp agrees to waive the suspension hearing and requests that the Commission issue an order suspending these proposed changes for investigation, and that a hearing to take testimony from the public be scheduled at the prehearing conference. Accordingly, the Company will provide notice to the public under WAC 480-100-197(2). In compliance with WAC 480-100-193(1), PacifiCorp will also post the proposed changes to its tariff sheets for public inspection and review on the company's website.
