Dear Mr. Borshch:

As you are aware, on June 24, 2021, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a penalty assessment against Tri City Excavation and BMI Construction in the amount of \$10,000 for violations of the Commission's dig laws. The penalty was due 15 days after the companies' receipt of that notice. On August 11, 2021, a Final Notice was sent to the companies in the amount of \$10,000, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest.
