Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), hereby submits for electronic filing with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), a revised Petition For an Accounting Order requesting authorization to utilize deferred accounting for all financial assistance distributed under the Washington Interim Participatory Funding Agreement (Agreement), as approved by the Commission as Attachment A to Order No. 01 in Docket No. U-210595. This filing complies with Article 7.9 of the Agreement.

Within this revised petition, at the request of Commission Staff, the Company has clarified that it only intends to defer actual financial assistance distributed for future recovery and not any other associated costs. In addition, the revised petition now includes reference to a natural gas docket, which is needed as financial assistance may be distributed for both electric or natural gas matters.
