Dear Mr. Moody:

As you are aware, on May 4, 2023, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Vision Landscapes in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of the Commission's rules and laws. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated June 21, 2023, indicating that the balance of \$1,000 was due. To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event, you will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
