## IMPORTANT NOTICE OF PROPOSED NATURAL GAS RATE CHANGE

May 3, 2023

Dear Customer,

Puget Sound Energy (PSE), on April 17, 2023, filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to increase rates under its natural gas Schedule 1 Tax Adjustment, effective June 3, 2023. This request follows the City of Kenmore's February 14, 2023 passage of Ordinance No. 23-0570 which increased its utility tax on the gross revenues of natural gas utilities from four to six percent.

The UTC allows PSE to increase the amount it charges customers to recover the cost of a municipal utility tax levy, along with additional taxes, fees and expenses associated with the collection of the municipal utility tax. With these adjustments, PSE made this filing in order to update the current rate of 4.360 percent to 6.686 percent, a 2.326 percent increase. The typical residential gas customer using an average of 64 therms per month would see an average monthly increase of \$2.07. This charge is shown on your PSE statement as *Effect of Kenmore City Tax.* Natural gas customers are billed monthly.

Bill assistance programs are available to qualified customers who need help with their energy bills. Payment plans are also available.

The UTC will review the filing and has the authority to set final rates that may vary from PSE's request, either higher or lower, or structured differently, depending on the results of its review.
