Thank you for filing Lewis County's 2023 – 2028 Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous West Management Plan.

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has completed its review of preliminary draft of the Lewis County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous West Management Plan Update (Plan).

There is an impact to customers in unincorporated areas because these customers fall under solid waste carriers, Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a City Sanitary Co., Joe's Refuse, and White Pass Garbage (G-98) that are regulated by the Commission.

The 2023-2028 Plan proposes to increase tip fees in 2024 by 10 percent and for years 2025-2028 by approximately 2.7 percent each year to keep up with inflation. As a result, there will be a minimal rate impact to ratepayers served by regulated solid waste collection companies in Lewis County. The County recently expanded recycling to include East Lewis County.
