The State of Washington to Baker Bus Ski and Snowboarding Club:

You are commanded to appear before the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission at the special virtual proceeding referenced in the attached Order and Notice of Hearing at 9:30 a.m., on May 7, 2025, and to remain there until discharged by the Commission to give testimony and evidence under oath as to the operations of Baker Bus Ski and Snowboarding Club d/b/a Baker Bus. Baker Bus shall appear virtually at the time and place set forth above unless the Executive Director and Secretary of the Commission, by notice of hearing, specifies a different time and place. This is ordered pursuant to the subpoena powers granted in RCW 34.05.446, RCW 80.01.060(1), and RCW 81.04.510.

To attend the hearing telephonically, you may call (253) 215-8782, enter Meeting ID: 880 9276 2431# and enter Passcode: 987107#. If you wish to attend via Zoom, please email kathryn.mcpherson@utc.wa.gov and a link will be provided to you.

You are further commanded to provide the following documents:

For a company seeking to avoid further enforcement action by ceasing unlawful operations and leaving the industry, you must provide sufficient documentation or records to demonstrate closure of your unauthorized charter party or excursion carrier service. In the case of those whose entire business involves charter party or excursion carrier service, those papers might include documentation from (1) the Secretary of State's office for dissolution of your business; (2) the Department of Revenue for cancellation of your business license; (3) your internet service provider (or equivalent) showing cancellation of a website or email account; (4) your telephone provider showing cancellation of your corporate telephone number; (5) proof of cancellation of your company advertising; and (6) sales receipts for any company equipment sold in the process of shutting down and closing. For those companies who continue with a business but only close that portion involving charter party or excursion carrier service, similar documentation (e.g., changed website or advertising) will prove most helpful to the presiding

officer. Should you choose to apply for a charter party or excursion service carrier certificate in advance of the hearing, and the Commission deems you eligible to receive a certificate, you may present that information at the hearing.

You must provide these documents in electronic form to Kathryn McPherson via email at kathryn.mcpherson@utc.wa.gov in advance of the hearing, together with your certification that the items produced are true and correct copies of the subpoenaed documents.
