PASSENGER RULES

Adult Fares: Published fares are adult fares and apply to passengers who have reached or passed their 12th birthday.

Children’s Fares: A child under the age of two will ride for free with an accompanying, fare-paying adult. This free fare only applies to one child per adult. Additional children under the age of two must pay the standard fare for children under twelve years of age, which is the ordinarily adult rate, discounted by ten percent (10%). Rocket Transportation will not transport unaccompanied children under the age of twelve. Children riding with Rocket Transportation must ride in a car seat in accordance with state law. Rocket Transportation will not provide car seats.

Unused tickets: Any completely unused tickets, paid for in advance, will remain valid for six months from the date of sale. A six month extension will be granted if requested prior to the end of the original six month life of the ticket. Only one extension will be granted.

Refunds: Unused tickets and unused portions of round-trip or commutation tickets may be redeemed for a refund. Such a refund will be calculated by charging the regular fares for the portion or portions used, and refunding the balance of the purchase price.

Round trip tickets: A round trip ticket may not be used as two separate one way tickets on separate trips. Although a passenger may seek a refund of the unused portion of a round-trip ticket, it will not be good for future travel.

Cancellations: Passengers who cancel a trip less than two full business days before scheduled pick up time will incur a standard cancellation charge, constituting 15% of the total booking price.

No Shows: A customer who has made a reservation but fails to properly cancel, reschedule, or appear at the designated pick-up point by the scheduled departure time is not eligible for a refund unless the failure was caused by an airline delay or cancellation.

Right of Refusal: Rocket Transportation reserves the right to deny any requested reservation for travel.

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Objectionable passengers: Rocket Transportation reserves the right to refuse service to any persons for any reason. Rocket Transportation also reserves the right to refuse carriage of any materials that its employees deem unsafe and/or not in the best interest of the passengers.

Schedule maintenance: Rocket Transportation will not be responsible for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, weather, highway/road conditions, or other factors beyond the control of Rocket Transportation and its employees. Rocket Transportation likewise does not guarantee arrival at, or departure from, any point at any specific time.

Odd luggage: Rocket Transportation will charge an additional fee for odd-sized luggage as follows:

Golf bag, fishing poles - \$5.00 each

Bicycles, surfboards - \$10.00 each

Other odd-sized luggage – as appropriate

Animals: Service animals traveling with sight or hearing-impaired passengers will be carried free of charge. Service animals will not be permitted to occupy a seat, but must lie or stand at the feet of the passenger. Other pets will be transported only when they are housed in pet carriers. The following rates apply for the transportation of pets:

Small carrier 21” x 16” x 15” \$5.00

Medium carrier 27” x 21½” x 20” \$10.00

Large carrier 36” x 24½” x 26” \$15.00

X-Large carrier 40” x 27” 30” \$20.00

Lost and found items: Rocket Transportation will not be responsible for items lost or left on any vehicle by passengers. Rocket Transportation will attempt to secure any such items at our office for up to thirty days but does not guarantee any protection or rightful return. Any items not claimed by rightful owner for a period exceeding thirty days shall be properly discarded or given to local charities.

Consistent Pricing: No passenger will be required to pay more for transportation to an intermediate point along a route than is charged for a longer trip over the same route.

Holidays Observed: Rocket Transportation will provide service by reservation, in accordance with its certificate, 365 days per year.

Note 1: The above fares are listed with the roundtrip fare on the left and a one way fare on the right.

Note 2: Any additional passengers traveling with a full fare passenger, may travel for a reduced, companion fare of \$70 (for either roundtrip or one way travel) if that is less expensive than a full fare. If full fare for the additional passengers would be less than \$70, the reduced companion fare will not apply. No other discounts may be used in conjunction with the companion fare.

Note 3: A 10% discount will be given to children under the age of twelve. Each child under the age of two, accompanied by a fare-paying adult may ride for free. This only applies to one child per adult. A 10% discount will also be given to passengers 65 years of age or older.

Note 4: A 15% discount will be given to active military personal.

Note 5: Because Rocket Transportation provides door-to-door service, fares are calculated based on the general areas of pick up and drop off, as opposed to precise locations. Therefore, the "West End" refers to pick up and drop off points west of Lake Crescent on Hwy 101 and west of Joyce on Hwy 112. 98363 refers to all areas within that zip code. 98363 refers to all areas within that zip code. Jefferson and Kitsap Counties refer to all areas within those counties.

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Door-to-door service is unscheduled.

Reservations must be made on at least 24 hours advance notice.

The actual time the vehicle will arrive to pick up passengers depends on the number of passengers making reservations, and the locations that those passengers request pickup. Rocket Transportation will develop actual routes to balance passenger convenience and company efficiency.

Service is available 365 days a year between 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. but Rocket Transportation reserves the right to provide service outside of these hours at its own discretion

Note: Rocket Transportation is not responsible for delays caused by weather, accidents, or other circumstances beyond its control.

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
