PAGE 1 – PETITION TO INTERVENE OF ICNU

2 The administrative rules at issue are WAC § 480-07-340, -355.

3 ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric
customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A.
Many members of ICNU purchase power from Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”), as indicated on
Attachment A.

4 ICNU’s member companies have a substantial interest in the proposed
acquisition of PSE by Puget Holdings LLC. ICNU seeks to intervene in this proceeding to
ensure that the proposed acquisition complies with Washington law and will not harm PSE’s
customers. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this docket to represent its members who are
affected by the proposed transaction.

5 ICNU’s intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in
resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay
this proceeding. ICNU also has extensive experience in proceedings involving PSE and in
Washington merger proceedings. ICNU has participated in PSE’s general rate cases and
power cost only rate proceedings. ICNU also participated in the proceeding in which Puget
Sound Power & Light Company and Washington Natural Gas Company merged into PSE, in
the ScottishPower purchase of PacifiCorp, and in the Mid-American Energy Holdings
Company acquisition of PacifiCorp.

6 As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this
proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected
by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding. It is in the
public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding. ICNU, therefore, requests that
the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and make ICNU a party to this proceeding.
