On December 29, 2021, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a draft 2022 All-Source Request for Proposals (RFP) for approval by the Commission, as specified in WAC Chapter 480-107. **2022 PacifiCorp All-source RFP – Preliminary Public Participation Schedule**

Per [WAC 480-107-017\(2\)](#), interested persons may submit written comments to the Commission within 45 days after the utility files its draft RFP, and [WAC 480-107-017\(4\)](#) provides for a 75- day period during which the Commission will decide whether to approve, approve with conditions, or suspend the filed draft RFP. Guided by these requirements, a preliminary public participation schedule is provided below and may be revised as needed.

The Commission will accept comments on PacifiCorp's Draft 2022 All-Source RFP. Written comments on the Draft 2022 All-Source RFP must be filed with the Commission no later than **5:00 p.m. on February 14, 2022**. The Commission requests that comments be provided in electronic format to enhance public access, for ease of providing comments, to reduce the need for paper copies, and to facilitate quotations from the comments.
