Please provide all documents reflecting the per-customer energy savings, by program, for each customer from a Highly Impacted Community or Vulnerable Population who participated in the programs reflected in the baseline data in Table 3-8.

Response:

Attached as Attachment A to Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE") Response to Front and Centered and NVEC Data Request No. 164 for a workbook providing per-customer energy savings (total kilowatt-hours) for customers who participated in energy efficiency programs reflected in Table 3-8 of PSE's Clean Energy Implementation Plan ("CEIP"). The workbook indicates whether each customer (associated with an anonymized identifier) resides in a highly impacted community ("HIC") and/or vulnerable populations ("VP") label of high, medium, or low.

Please note that the percentages of customers in each HIC and/or VP category in the attached workbook differ slightly from the values reflected in Table 3-8 of PSE's CEIP. The data attached are at a per-customer level, as requested, whereas Table 3-8 used total measure count of the customer population. Please see footnote 32 on page 74 of the CEIP.

The distributed energy resource programs in Table 3-8 are not associated with specific per-customer energy savings; therefore, PSE has reported per-customer data for the Energy Efficiency program.
