5 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

6 A. My name is Suzanne L. Tamayo. My business address is Puget Sound Energy,

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

9 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director of IT Shared
10 Services.

11 **Q. What are your duties as Director of IT Shared Services?**

12 A. I am responsible for oversight of PSE’s IT Capital portfolio management and IT
13 Program and Project delivery. I also have responsibility for the IT Service
14 Management Office and the Project Practices Center of Excellence.

15 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

16 A. I hold a Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics from the University of Washington. I
17 began my career with Safeco Insurance where I held multiple technology and
18 program and project leadership positions in the IT department during my 17-year
19 tenure. I then worked at REI as a Program and Project Manager for three years
20 before joining PSE in 2010. I have held a variety of roles as PSE, with increasing
21 leadership oversight. Initially, I had responsibility for creating an IT Infrastructure

Project Management Office (“PMO”) and managing a staff of both employee and contractor Project Managers. I then created and managed a centralized IT PMO, with responsibility for IT program and project delivery. I was also a member of the PSE team responsible for initiating and organizing the Get to Zero program. In my current role, I have continued responsibility for IT Capital portfolio management and program and project delivery. I also oversee other IT Shared Service teams, including the IT Service Management Office, IT Planning and I co-sponsor the Project Practices Center of Excellence, which seeks to increase Project Management maturity and standardization of practices and processes across PSE.
