NOTICE CANCELING ORAL ARGUMENT SESSION

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 29, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Prehearing Conference Order in the above-referenced docket adopting a procedural schedule that reserved a time and date for oral argument on pending motions. The order advised the parties that the Commission would confirm or cancel the oral argument session no later than December 24, 2012.
