RESPONSE:

Electric –

Revenue Requirement = expenses + depreciation + income taxes + (return*rate base)

Natural Gas -

Revenue Requirement = expenses + depreciation + income taxes + (return*rate base)

Water Distribution –

Revenue Requirement = expenses + depreciation + income taxes + (return*rate base)

Revenue requirement equals recoverable expense including depreciation and income taxes plus a fair return on investment.
