Dear Ms. Washburn:

Pursuant to WAC 480-09-736, enclosed for filing are corrections to the record and transcripts of the hearing in the above-referenced proceeding. During the hearing, various questions were addressed to Howard Fox, a witness for the Olympic Pipe Line Company ("Olympic"). Some of these questions were asked "subject to check." The following are corrections to the record after Mr. Fox's review of the information.

First, at pages 4369-4370 of the transcript, Mr. Trotter questioned Mr. Fox and asked the following:

Q. Okay. So what is the -- you have currently \$139 Million in notes outstanding, correct?

A. Subject to check, yes.

Q. And how much interest and principal has been accrued and not paid?

A. At this juncture it's -- I believe it's over \$9 Million, but that's also subject to check. I have not looked at the income statements.

Mr. Fox would like to clarify the record by stating that the amount of \$139 Million should actually be closer to \$140 million.

Mr. Fox would like to state that the amount of \$9 Million in the transcript should be \$10.9 million.

Second, at page 4380, lines 17-20 of the transcript, Mr. Trotter further questioned Mr. Fox, asking.

Q. Would you accept subject to your check that the Chase note had no parent guarantees when it was issued?

A. Sure.

In fact, Mr. Fox states that his response was incorrect. Per Mr. Fox, according to Chase, the loan has always been backed by a parent guarantee.
