**RESPONSE:**

Of the \$278,895 invoiced in the test year:  
\$9,482 was charged to non-utility and not included in revenue requirement.  
\$133,440 was charged to Washington Gas.  
\$52,549 was charged to Idaho Gas.  
\$83,424 was charged to Oregon Gas.
