On August 31, 1994, The Disposal Group, Inc., filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission a complaint against Waste Management Disposal Services of Oregon, Inc., and T&G Trucking & Freight Co.

The complaint was docketed under Commission rule, and answers were filed. Because the facts underlying the complaint appeared to be without substantial dispute, and because the complainant desired expedited consideration and decision, the Commission with the parties' consent scheduled the matter for brief adjudication under RCW 34.05.482, et seq., and WAC 480-12-500. The matter was heard upon stipulated facts.

The presiding officer entered an initial order on brief adjudication on December 20, 1994, proposing dismissal of the complaint. No party objected to the initial order. Under RCW 34.05.491, the Commission adopts the order as its own for purposes of this proceeding.

In doing so the Commission adopts the initial order's findings and conclusions for purposes of the proceeding, finding them sufficient and the order's result acceptable in light of the parties' lack of objection. The Commission observes that this order does not constitute precedent for any purpose.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. The Initial Order on Brief Adjudication in Docket No. TG-941154 is affirmed and adopted.
- 2. The Complaint of The Disposal Group, Inc., against Waste Management Disposal Services of Oregon, Inc., and T&G Trucking & Freight Co. is dismissed.
