NOTICE REQUIRING STAFF RESPONSE
(By Thursday, August 15, 2019)

RE: *Wash. Utils. & Transp. Comm'n v. JFS Transport Inc. d/b/a Coast Movers*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 24, 2018, the Commission approved a settlement agreement between JFS Transport Inc. d/b/a Coast Movers (JFS Transport or Company) and Commission staff (Staff) in Order 02 in this docket.

On July 31, 2019, the Company contacted Administrative Law Judge Andrew J. O'Connell via email requesting for the "2 year probation to be terminated after payment of full balance is made."¹ A copy of the email message to Judge O'Connell has been filed in this docket.

The Commission interprets pleadings and motions to effect just results.² The Commission exercises its discretion to consider the Company's email as a request to modify the Settlement Agreement approved by Order 02.

To assist the Commission in evaluating the Company's request, the Commission requires Staff to file a response in the form of a letter addressed to the undersigned administrative law judge indicating its position regarding the Company's request no later than **5 p.m. on Thursday, August 15, 2019.**

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That Staff must file a response to JFS Transport's request to modify the Settlement Agreement approved by Order 02 no later than 5 p.m. on Thursday, August 15, 2019.
