BACKGROUND

1 On September 23, 2024, Eagle Towncar Service LLC, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide the following service:

SCHEDULED NONSTOP PASSENGER BY RESERVATION ONLY
BETWEEN downtown Bellevue Hotels and Sea-Tac Airport. Pickup/drop from Westin Bellevue, Hyatt Regency Bellevue, Hilton Garden Bellevue, Hilton Bellevue, Marriott Bellevue, and Seattle Tacoma (SeaTac) Airport via Interstate 405.

2 The application appeared on the September 25, 2024, application docket.

3 On October 15, 2024, an objection to the Application was filed on behalf of Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a Capital Aeroporter Airport Shuttle; Capital Aeroporter Tours & Charters; Airport Shuttle; Capital City Charters; Premier Airport Shuttle.

4 On November 27, 2024, the Commission subsequently entered Order 01 in this docket. Order 01 overruled the objection filed by Pacific Northwest Transportation Services and approved Eagle Towncar's Temporary Application.

5 After reviewing the application, Commission staff (Staff) determined that the application complies with the Commission's requirements for an auto transportation authority and recommends that the Commission grant the Company's application.

DISCUSSION AND DECISION

6 The Commission, having considered the application and being fully advised, finds that the Company is fit, willing, and able to provide the proposed extended service and that the proposed temporary service extension is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 7 (1) The application for a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity
filed by the Company in this docket is granted. The Company's temporary
certificate TAC071487 is provided in Appendix A to this order.
- 8 (2) The tariffs and time schedules for the Company filed in connection with this
application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service
date of this Order.
- 9 (3) The length of service granted for this temporary certificate of public convenience
and necessity shall not exceed 180 days from the date of this order unless the
Company files an auto transportation certificate application for the same authority
within 30 days of this order. If that occurs, this certificate will remain active until
the Commission either grants, denies, or dismisses that certificate application.
- 10 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW
80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(6)(c).
