The Commission, January 16, 1990, entered its Fourth Supplemental Order in this docket rejecting the suspended tariff filing and authorizing U S WEST Communications (USWC) to refile certain tariff revisions complying with terms of the order.

On February 5, 1990, the Commission received a tariff filing from USWC, designated for reference as Docket No. UT-900118.

## FINDINGS

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by USWC, February 5, 1990, are, except as noted below, in accordance with the intent of the Commission's Fourth Supplemental Order in Docket Nos. U-89-2698-F and U-89-3245-P and that the tariff revisions should become effective as filed.

The company's advice letter (No. 2095T) accompanying this filing states that "The annual revenue effect of this filing is a reduction of \$65M, with a cumulative \$337.75M effect over five years in revenue reductions and service improvements." However, since the tariffs approved by this order do not take effect until February 15, 1990, the actual reduction for 1990 will be \$8.14 million less than \$65 million, and the total for the five year period through December 31, 1994 will be less than \$337.75 million.

## ORDER

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS That the tariff revisions filed herein by USWC, February 5, 1990, and with an inserted effective date of February 15, 1990, which are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof as though

fully set forth herein, shall become effective as filed, and that the rates, charges and conditions therein are hereby specified as the rates, charges and conditions to be applicable to service on and after February 15, 1990.

The company is ordered to reconcile this discrepancy by filing additional temporary tariffs reducing rates by \$8.14 million during 1990. This filing shall bear an effective date not later than March 15, 1990.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That jurisdiction is retained by the Commission to effectuate the provisions of this and prior orders entered in this docket.
