REFUND ADJUSTMENT SCHEDULE NO. 699

APPLICABLE:

This adjustment applies to gas service rendered by the Company under which this schedule is a part for service on and after the effective date hereof and shall be in addition to the rates and charges of Rate Schedule No. 663 and Rate Schedule No. 678.

MONTHLY RATES AND MINIMUM BILLS:

Each of the charges, except Dispatching Service Charge, of Schedule No. 663 and Schedule No. 678 are to be decreased by \$0.08000 per therm or an appropriate multiple thereof. However, the total amount of credit issued in any month shall not exceed customer's total bill for that month. Such rate shall remain in effect until the principal plus interest of the following sub accounts of Account No. 2530, Refund Adjustment - Washington are extinguished or for a period of twenty four months, whichever is less. Any amounts remaining at the end of the twenty four month period shall be disbursed to all WN U-3 customers as a prospective rate decrease.
