You have protested this application. Why?

- A. There are already two medical waste service providers in our area, Rubatino and Stericycle. There is not sufficient business to support a third carrier. We currently have 84 customers, nearly all of whom are smaller providers. A third entry into this market would dilute it even further, putting our investment of time, energy and capital at risk. We are also concerned about "cream skimming." We are fearful that if this application is granted Kleen will concentrate on the urban large facility market and ignore the rural small providers.
- Q. If your share of the market increases, do you have the financial ability to purchase additional equipment and/or hire additional staff to meet the need?
- A. Yes, we are financially sound. I have attached our balance sheet as Exhibit _____ (RG-4).

Definition of Terms and Description of Service

1. For service provided to customers under this tariff, the customers shall pay Rubatino Refuse Removal the rates as set forth in this tariff.

2. Rubatino Refuse Removal warrants:

- a. It understands the currently known hazards which are presented to persons, property and the environment in the transportation, storage and disposal of the Infectious Waste Material;
- b. It will transport, store and dispose of the Infectious Waste Material in full compliance with all Federal EPA and Washington State laws and regulations.
- c. The waste management facilities utilized are now licensed and permitted to store and dispose of waste materials within the description of the Infectious Waste Material Profile:
- d. In the event such waste management facilities lose permitted status, Rubatino Refuse Removal will promptly notify its customers of such loss;
- e. Carrier will provide staff with initial and continuing training in handling, transportation and disposal of biohazardous medical wastes.

3. The customers warrant:

- a. Infectious waste material transferred by the customers will be packaged in Rubatino containers and suitably protected from damage until time of pickup;
- b. It shall communicate, on an ongoing basis, the nature and content of the infectious waste material tendered for transportation and disposal, and will continue to communicate to Rubatino those hazards and risks known or learned by the customer to be incident to the handling, transportation, storage, treatment and disposal of the infectious waste material;
- c. If the infectious waste material is, or contains, hazardous substances as defined pursuant to Section 101 of the Federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, the customer will advise Rubatino in writing, prior to tendering or delivering to Rubatino (or its deligatee) any vehicular load of infectious waste material containing a reportable quantity of any hazardous substance or substance pursuant to Section 102 of said Act, specifying those hazardous substances present in a reportable quantity;
- d. If any infectious waste material is covered by requirements of any state laws or regulations relating to hazardous wastes or hazardous materials, it will comply with all applicable requirements of such laws or regulations.
- 4. Scheduled service shall be any service which is regularly scheduled as to specific date(s) or day(s) each month with consistent frequency.
