The parties in the above-referenced docket have reached a full settlement of this matter. A Settlement Agreement and supporting Testimony by Mr. Kermode on behalf of Commission Staff will be filed today.


Under WAC 480-07-730(1), when a full settlement is reached, the rule states "Parties that file a full settlement should file supporting evidence at the same time as the settlement agreement..." It is not clear whether this rule requires only one party to file testimony if the other parties concur in that testimony or whether it requires all parties to file testimony in support of the full settlement. In any event, Canterwood Water Company supports the Testimony filed by Mr. Kermode in this matter. Should WAC 480-07-730(1) be read as a requirement that all parties file supporting testimony, then Canterwood Water Company respectfully requests a waiver of such requirement. The waiver is requested to promote the efficient and speedy resolution of this matter.

The parties have requested consideration of the Settlement Agreement at the Commission's earliest opportunity. Canterwood is in full support of that request.
