Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to ordering provisions of the Commission's Order Adopting Implementation Plan, issued on May 19, 2016 in this docket, the tri-chairs of Consumer Education and Technical Subcommittee hereby submit their fourth overlay implementation status report.

The Customer Education and Technical subcommittee (an industry group comprised of carriers that provide service in the 206, 253, 360 and 425 area codes) has been meeting monthly since July, 2016 as the subcommittee prepared for start of permissive 10 digit dialing that began on January 28, 2017 and for the start of mandatory 10 digit dialing that began on July 29, 2017. A copy of the minutes of the most recent meeting (September 27, 2017) is attached as Exhibit 1. The subcommittee has established milestone dates for activities to complete customer education and technical tasks for both the start of permissive and mandatory dialing. A copy of the now completed milestone matrix is attached as Exhibit 2.


The 564 code overlay has been successfully deployed. It is working as expected. A code has been assigned to one carrier. That code has been successfully tested with all major carriers. It is expected that the code will be operational by the end of the month.
