On June 19, 2020, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-3 for natural gas service. The purpose of the filing is to increase rates and charges for natural gas service provided to customers in the state of Washington. Specifically, Cascade requests authority to increase charges and rates for natural gas service by approximately \$13.8 million, or 5.283 percent in base rates.

On July 13, 2020, the Commission entered its Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (PHC Notice), which, among other things, set time for an evidentiary hearing beginning on Wednesday, February 24, 2021, at 9 a.m., continuing if needed on Thursday, February 25, 2021. Due to uncertainties surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, the PHC Notice did not establish whether the hearing would be held in-person or virtually.
