1. Q. Please state your name and business address.

A. Captain E. Michael Bopp, 8712 Highway 23, Belle Chasse, Louisiana 70037.

2. Q. Whom do you represent and in what capacity?

A. I represent the River Port Pilots for the Port of New Orleans, duly organized pursuant to La.

R.S. §§ 34:992 and 34:995 as the Crescent River Port Pilots' Association, a Louisiana nonprofit corporation taxed as a partnership (hereafter "CRPPA" or the "Association"). I have
been an active pilot and partner in the Association since 1997. I served as Chairman of the
CRPPA Political Action Committee from 2000 to 2016. I served on the CRPPA Board of
Directors from 2002 to 2006, again from 2010 to 2012, and from 2014 to 2016. In 2012, I
also served as Vice President of the Association, and since December 2016, have held the
position of President of the Association. As President, I oversee all operations of our
Association, which currently has 120 pilot partners. However, with seven (7) apprentice
pilots in training and scheduled to be commissioned July 1, 2019, the pilot complement will
increase to 124, after consideration of three (3) pilot retirements effective December 31,
2019. I am also a duly appointed member of the Louisiana Pilotage Fee Commission (the
"Fee Commission"), representing the interests of pilots.

3. Q. Have you ever submitted testimony to a state regulatory agency before?

A. Yes. I have provided testimony before the Louisiana Pilotage Fee Commission in Docket No. P17-002, as well as in the captioned docket and Docket Nos. P15-002 and P15-003.

4. Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding before the Fee Commission?

A. The purpose of my testimony is to present CRPPA's projected expenses for 2020, as required by Order No. P07-001. Pursuant to Order No. P07-001, the Fee Commission approved an annual true-up mechanism, to provide for adjustment of CRPPA's projected

and actual annual expenses. The true-up methodology requires that the Association calculate and file projected expenses for the upcoming year in November of the current year, as well as the necessary adjustments of tariff rates and fees, based upon actual expense experience, as annualized, plus known and measurable future expenses.

5. Q. Who else will testify for CRPPA?

A. In addition to my testimony, Mark L. Nelson, CPA, CRPPA's Chief Financial Officer, will provide more detailed testimony regarding the Association's projected 2020 expenses and the appropriateness of those projections.

6. Q. Would you please summarize CRPPA's projected operating and administrative expenses for 2020, including annual pilot compensation?

A. CRPPA's operating and administrative expenses for 2020 totals \$70,511,346, or \$940,347 more than last year. This results in a 1.35% increase in total revenue recovery for 2020 over the required expense recovery in 2019 (\$69,570,999), after adding the under-recovery of expenses in 2018 (\$151,990), deducting the decrease in known and measurable expenses in 2020 (\$481,574), adding the increase in 2019 annualized expenses over those projected (\$1,378,511) and reversing the under-recovery of 2017 expenses (\$108,580). Projected operating and administrative expenses for 2020 total \$16,358,469, which results in an increase of \$896,937, or 5.80% over those projected in 2019 (\$15,461,531). Mr. Nelson will testify to the detailed data that supports CRPPA's 2020 projected increase in expenses.

7. Q. What was the effect of the "true-up" of 2018 expenses?

A. CRPPA projected its 2018 expenses to be \$15,159,436, and its audited expenses for 2018 totaled \$15,256,305, or \$96,869 more than projected. However, annualized expenses for 2018 were projected to be \$55,121 less than originally projected in November 2017. Thus,

an under-recovery of expenses in the amount of \$151,990 occurred in 2018. Accordingly, that amount will be added to the projected 2020 revenue requirement.

8. Q. Does this conclude your testimony?

A. Yes.

1. Q. Please state your name and business address.

A. Mark L. Nelson, CPA, 8712 Highway 23, Belle Chasse, Louisiana 70037.

2. Q. Whom do you represent and in what capacity?

A. I represent the River Port Pilots for the Port of New Orleans, duly organized pursuant to La. R.S. §§ 34:992 and 34:995 as the Crescent River Port Pilots' Association, a Louisiana non-profit corporation, taxed as a partnership (hereafter "CRPPA" or the "Association"). I previously served as the Chief Operating Officer for CRPPA from 2009 through 2017. Since January 2018, I have held the position of Chief Financial Officer for CRPPA. As Chief Financial Officer, I am responsible for supervising the day-to-day administrative, financial, and accounting functions of CRPPA, including management of payables, receivables, and the financial reporting function. I am also responsible for gathering, computing, and analyzing annual and comparative financial data for revenue forecasting, ratemaking, and other purposes.

3. Q. What is your educational and professional background?

A. I earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from Louisiana Tech University. I am also a Certified Public Accountant, certified by the State of Louisiana in 1992. Prior to working for the Association, I served in various financial management positions, most recently as President/Business Manager for Wadleigh Energy Group, an offshore service company. I held that position for four years.

4. Q. Have you ever submitted testimony to a regulatory agency before?

A. Yes. I have previously submitted testimony before the Louisiana Pilotage Fee Commission (the "Commission") in connection with CRPPA rate proceedings and annual true-up and cost of living adjustment filings.

5. Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding before the Commission?

A. The purpose of my testimony is to provide the financial information that supports CRPPA's 2020 projected expenses.

6. Q. Describe the CRPPA's projected expenses for 2020.

A. CRPPA's 2020 projected expenses are itemized in Exhibit No. MLN-1.

7. Q. Do the 2020 expense projections in Exhibit No. MLN-1 contemplate an increase or decrease when compared to 2019 expenses?

A. The calculations provided in Exhibit No. MLN-1 reflect an increase in projected expenses in 2020 of \$896,937, or 5.80%.

8. Q. What information is presented in Exhibit No. MLN-2?

A. These calculations reflect that operating and administrative expenses for 2020 will increase by the 2019 annualized expenses greater than those projected (\$1,378,511), and increase by the under-recovery of 2018 expenses (\$151,990). However, operating and administrative expenses for 2020 will decrease by the reversal of the under-recovery of 2017 expenses (\$108,580), and decrease by known and measurable 2020 expenses in the amount of \$481,571. These changes will result in a total increase of 1.35% in the overall revenue requirement under the 2020 tariff.

9. Q. What information is presented in Exhibit No. MLN-3?

A. The tariff adjustments necessary to generate the total annual revenue requirement are presented in attached Exhibit No. MLN-3.

10. Q. What are the major drivers of the increase in operating and administrative expenses? Have any expenses materially declined?

A. Though expenses in 2019 have remained relatively flat over those projected last November, CRPPA again projects a moderate increase in 2020 operating and administrative expenses. As stated above, the total projected increase in 2020 is \$896,937, approximately 5.80%. CRPPA projects cost increases in the areas of Group Hospitalization and Benefits, Pilot Station Expenses, Professional Dues, Insurance Expense, and Legal Fees and Expenses. The increase in Group Hospitalization and Benefits results from a combination of CRPPA's projection of an increase to health insurance premiums for 2020, as well as an increase in CRPPA's pilot complement, thereby increasing the number of people insured under CRPPA's policy. Pilot Station Costs will increase due to necessary air conditioning and generator repairs. The increase in Professional Dues is caused by an increase in the required dues of the American Pilots' Association, which is the national trade association of the piloting profession. CRPPA's insurance expenses are also projected to increase. CRPPA has not made any claims; however, CRPPA's insurance expenses are still projected to increase due to rising insurance premiums nationally. Lastly, CRPPA projects an increase in Legal Fees and Expenses, resulting from CRPPA's need to prepare for its upcoming rate case proceeding.

11. Q. What information is presented in Exhibit No. MLN-4?

A. Exhibit No. MLN-4 presents a comparison of the Crescent River Port Pilots' 2019 and 2020 projected expense budgets in the format approved by the Uniform Financial Reporting Committee in 2012.

12. Q. Does this conclude your testimony?

A. Yes.
