TO ALL PARTIES:

On Friday, February 27, 2009, protestant B&N Sanitary Service filed an *Objection to Data Requests*. On Wednesday, March 4, 2009, applicant American on Site Services filed its *Motion of Petitioner for Leave to Pursue Discovery*. The Commission notes that both of these filings relate to a similar, if not the same, issue, and should be decided with one order.
