This e-mail is to inform you of a public meeting scheduled for January 27, 1:30 – 3:30 at the PSE Auditorium (map and directions attached). Those of you that are members of the IRP Advisory Group may receive a duplicate notice.

The purpose of this meeting is to present and discuss the ten-year cumulative conservation potential and biennial conservation target that PSE will file by January 29, in accordance with the requirements of WAC 480-109-010.

The WAC rule for utilities to report their ten-year conservation potential and biennial target is as follows:

WAC 480-109 (3) (b) This report must identify whether the conservation council's plan or the utility's IRP and acquisition process were the source of its ten-year conservation potential. The report must also clearly state how the utility prorated this ten-year projection to create its two-year conservation target.

PSE will file its achievable ten-year conservation potential and biennial conservation target for 2010 - 2011 using the Northwest Power & Conservation Council's 5th Regional Plan as the basis. As identified to the IRP Advisory Group and Conservation Resources Advisory Group on December 31, 2009, PSE's share of the Council's 5th Power Plan, which is the plan currently in effect, is a cumulative ten-year potential of 219.3 aMW (1,921,253 MWh), with a 2010 - 2011 two year pro rata share of 42.7 aMW (374,244 MWh). A copy of the Council's 5th Power Plan calculator, showing PSE's share of the regional plan, is attached. PSE has used Option 2 as the method for calculating its share of the power plan.
