

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR SHERRY LICHTENBERG

Senior Manager, Operations Support Systems Interfaces/Facilities Development for WorldCom, Inc., and its predecessor MCI Telecommunications Corporation. I oversee MCI's national local market systems development and market entry for both UNE-P and facilities-based products. My responsibilities include working with MCI's internal systems development and service teams to determine local market entry requirements and working with the ILECs across the country to analyze and assess their OSS systems. I have testified as an expert witness on OSS interfaces and network issues in a variety of Section 271 proceedings and in Interconnection Agreement negotiations across the country. I have participated in workshops addressing OSS for all ILECs. I am now focusing on the development of MCI's mass markets UNE-L product and the resolution of issues relevant to the Triennial Review Order that relate to the migration of UNE-P customers to UNE-L.
