- 1 On February 12, 2001, Winstar Wireless, Inc. (“Winstar”), filed a petition to intervene in this proceeding. At a prehearing conference on February 15, 2001, the Commission found that Winstar’s petition was late-filed, and allowed Winstar to supplement its petition on February 20, 2001. Other parties were allowed to file responses to Winstar’s petition.
- 2 Teligent Services, Inc. (“Teligent”), filed comments in support of Winstar’s petition on February 27, 2001. Teligent is the only party that filed a response. Teligent states that it has similar interests with Winstar and that it expects to co-sponsor testimony and other pleadings.
- 3 Winstar states that it has a limited scope of interest in Part B of this proceeding. Winstar does not seek to file testimony or call witnesses in Part B, but may, if permitted, cross-examine other witnesses and submit written pleadings. Further, Winstar states that it has a substantial interest in the issues raised in Part C. Winstar seeks full participation in Part C in order to protect its interests in the state of Washington. Winstar also represents that it will not unreasonably broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.
- 4 Winstar shows good cause in support of its petition to intervene, and Winstar’s petition is granted subject to conditions. Winstar may not broaden the issues or delay the proceeding. Because of the late date of its petition in relation to Part B hearings in this proceeding, Winstar and Teligent must jointly coordinate their presentations in Part B, including cross-examination of witnesses and submission of written arguments and/or motions.
- 5 Communications with Winstar should be directed to its counsel, and an updated Parties' Representatives List is attached to this Order. Where more than one

representative's name appears, the representative designated to receive service from other parties appears in capital letters. Parties are not required to make service to more than one representative for other parties. The Parties' Representatives List applies to all proceedings conducted under this docket.

- 6 **NOTICE TO PARTIES: Any objection to the provisions of this Order must be filed within ten (10) days after the date of mailing of this document, pursuant to WAC 480- 09-430(3) and WAC 480-09-760.**
