5 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

6 A. My name is Roque B. Bamba, and my business address is Puget Sound Energy,
7 355 110th Ave. NE, Bellevue, WA 98004.

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

9 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director of Project Delivery.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Director of Project Delivery of PSE?**

11 A. I am responsible for project management activities that support PSE’s power
12 generation, transmission and distribution delivery, and other departments, as
13 business needs warrant.

14 I verify that work performed is compliant with federal, state, and local codes, PSE
15 standards, policies, field procedures, and relevant governing agreements. I make
16 sure public and worker safety measures are a driving force within the
17 organization, while at the same time managing customer service, quality, and
18 costs. I collaboratively interface with other PSE departments, resources, and
19 regulatory agencies and other discipline-related organizations. I direct the
20 effective (emphasis on proactive and preventive) identification and mitigation of

1 project risks. I provide visible and proactive leadership and coaching to develop
2 staff and achieve business results.

3 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

4 A. I have been employed at Puget Sound Energy for over 22 years and have held a
5 variety of Operations, Project Management, and leadership roles. I was a project
6 manager for approximately 10 years and managed gas and electric transmission
7 and distribution projects, as well as generation projects including the rebuild of
8 the Snoqualmie Falls Hydroelectric Plant and construction of the Lower Baker
9 Unit 4 Powerhouse. In addition, I managed the Major Projects team for
10 approximately six years prior to my current role. I hold a Bachelor's Degree in
11 Land Use Planning from Central Washington University and a Master's
12 Certification in Project Management from George Washington University.
