## RE: Cascade Natural Gas Company – Environmental Remediation Deferral Reporting Docket UG-100589

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On March 29, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Order Granting Cascade's Motion to Amend Order 01,<sup>1</sup> allowing Cascade to file annual reports for the environmental remediation of the Bremerton Site and include the amount of expenses deferred in the period and the balance to date, along with a summary of the status of remediation.

On February 20, 2020, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade) filed an annual environmental remediation deferral report for the Bremerton Site. The report includes the amount of expenses deferred in the period ended December 31, 2019, and a summary of the status of remediation.

Commission Staff reviewed the compliance filing provided by Cascade dated February 20, 2020, and finds that it complies with the Commission's Order 02, entered March 29, 2018.
