- Q. Please state your name and business address.
- A. My name is David E. Mills. My business address is 10885 N.E. 4th Street, P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue WA 98009-9734.
- Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
- A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as Vice President, Energy Operations.
- Q. What are your duties as Vice President, Energy Operations?
- As Vice President, Energy Operations, I am responsible for the oversight of PSE's A. Generation and Natural Gas Resources, Power & Gas Supply Operations Load Serving Operations, Transmission Contracts, and Energy Supply Operations Policy, Planning & Compliance groups. This includes management of PSE's short- and medium-term wholesale power and natural gas portfolios (up to three years) and involvement with planning for long-term hedging requirements in addition to PSE's transmission functions as they pertain to the Load Office and operating the Balancing Authority.
- Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.
- Α. I graduated from Portland State University in 1987 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics.

I have over twenty-six years of experience in the energy/utility industry, with extensive experience in the areas of trading and risk management issues. Prior to joining PSE, I worked with the Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA") for a total of eighteen years. I began my career initially in the economic and demand forecasting division, and later moved into BPA's Transmission Business Line in 1994. While employed in BPA's Transmission Business Line, I led the Agency's retail wheeling public process to support deregulation and open transmission access.

In 1998, I became the Trading Floor Manager for BPA's Bulk Power Marketing Group. In this capacity I was responsible for BPA's secondary wholesale marketing activities, including energy trading and real time hydro operations. I also managed the price risk assessment and analyses of hydro operations and long-term power purchases.

In 2002, I joined PSE as Director, Energy Supply and Planning, and in 2012, I became Vice President of Energy Supply Operations. In 2015, I became Vice President of Energy Operations with additional responsibility of managing PSE's generation and natural gas resources.
