A. I began my career with Qwest (formerly Mountain Bell) in 1964 in the Denver
13 Operator Services Department. In 1968, I joined the Network Facilities Department
14 as a technical assistant. From 1968 to 1978, I held various positions in which I was
15 responsible for coordinating and designing outside plant facilities. In 1978, I was
16 promoted to Budget Manager and was responsible for preparing and forecasting the
17 construction and maintenance budgets for the networks in Arizona, Colorado,
18 Montana and Wyoming.

In May 1984, after the divestiture of the Bell System, I accepted a position in the

Revenue Requirements Department. In that position, I was responsible for cost

21

settlements with local exchange carriers. My responsibilities included analyzing

22

cost separation studies. In January 1990, I was promoted to Senior Access Manager

and had responsibility for developing and negotiating contractual arrangements for

24

toll access compensation with local exchange carriers. I accepted the position of

1 Manager – Wholesale Markets in March 1998, and assumed responsibilities relating
2 to interconnection and resale products and services.
