

potentially compete with telecommunications services and/or products that are or could be offered by Qwest Corporation in conjunction with an Alternative Form of Regulation, to the extent such consultation or advice involves matters for which the "highly confidential" information would be relevant; and

- d. I have read and understand, and agree to be bound by, the terms of the Protective Order in this proceeding, including this Section C of the Protective Order.
