NOTICE EXTENDING TIME FOR QWEST TO SUBMIT COMPLIANCE FILINGS PENDING RESOLUTION OF PETITIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION

TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

On January 31, 2001, the Commission served the Thirteenth Supplemental Order ("Part A Order"). The Part A Order requires Qwest Corporation to submit certain compliance filings to the Commission no later than March 7, 2001.

On March 2, 2001, Qwest requested an extension of time to submit compliance filings pending resolution of issues raised in petitions for reconsideration. On March 5, 2001, the Commission granted an extension for a specified short term pending the receipt of responses to the request from other parties. No responses were filed.

The Commission finds that Qwest's requested continuance appears proper and is fully granted. Qwest must submit compliance filings required by the Part A Order no later than 14 days after service of the Commission's pending order resolving petitions for reconsideration or as further ordered by the Commission.
