Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 02

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On October 10, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) issued a penalty assessment against Iron Man Movers and Storage, Inc., (Iron Man Movers or company), in the amount of \$42,800 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-555, Criminal Background Checks for Prospective Employees; WAC 480-15-560, Equipment Safety Requirements; and WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements.

On November 8, 2017, the commission entered Order 01, which reduced the penalty to \$37,100. On January 26, 2018, the commission entered Order 02, which suspended \$25,100 of the \$37,100 penalty imposed in Order 01 for a period two years, subject to the condition that Iron Man Movers paid the \$12,000 unsuspended portion of the penalty in accordance with the payment schedule provided in Order 02.

On February 3, 2020, the company completed payment of the \$12,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended. Staff finds that Iron Man Movers satisfied the condition of Order 02, and recommends that the \$25,100 suspended penalty be waived.
