Dear Mr. Miller:

As you are aware, on April 24, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 02 in this matter to impose on Silver Transportation a penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for violations of the Commission's laws and rules. On June 9, 2020, the Commission entered Order 03, granting the parties' requested payment arrangement, which the Commission canceled by letter, then reinstated by entering Order 04. On September 24, 2021, Commission Staff filed a letter stating that Silver Transportation failed to make the first three payments or request an extension, and on October 5, 2021, the Commission issued a letter canceling the payment arrangement due to the company's failure to comply with the terms of Order 04. On September 2, 2021, a Corrected Final Notice was sent to the company, in the amount of \$10,000, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to the outstanding \$10,000 balance.
