#### WASTE ACCEPTANCE PROTOCOL

Stericycle policy requires compliance with all applicable regulations regarding the collection, transportation and treatment of regulated medical waste. Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) Regulations require the generator of regulated medical waste to certify that the packaging and documentation of transported regulated medical waste complies with DOT regulations regarding waste classification, packaging, labeling and shipping documentation. To ensure that neither Stericycle nor the generator of regulated medical waste violates applicable regulations, it is imperative that all parties understand the rules regarding proper identification, classification, segregation and packaging of regulated medical waste. The purpose of this policy is to summarize the minimum requirements for preparing your medical waste for collection, transportation and treatment. Additional facility or state-specific waste acceptance policies may apply based on permit specifications. Please contact your local representative.

#### **REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE**

Stericycle accepts medical waste generated in a broad range of medical diagnostic, therapeutic and research activities. The term "medical waste" includes biohazardous, biomedical, infectious or regulated medical waste as defined under federal, state or local laws, rules, regulations and guidelines. Except as defined by specific state regulations, this excludes pharmaceuticals, waste containing mercury or other heavy metals, chemicals such as solvents, reagents, corrosives or ignitable materials classified as hazardous waste under Federal EPA Regulations. Stericycle cannot accept these excluded materials. In addition, Stericycle cannot accept bulk liquids or chemotherapy waste, radioactive materials, fetal remains or human torsos. Separate protocol and packaging requirements apply for the disposal of non-hazardous pharmaceuticals.

Please contact your local representative for details and packaging specifications. Before accepting pharmaceutical waste from your facility, we must have on file a signed Pharmaceutical Waste Acceptance Protocol. This protocol outlines the bags and labeling that are required. It also gives some guidelines as to what can be considered a hazardous pharmaceutical. If you would like us to pick up your expired pharmaceuticals, please contact our customer service department.

#### WASTE SEGREGATION AND PACKAGING

The generator is solely responsible for properly segregating, packaging and labeling of regulated medical waste. Proper segregation and packaging reduces the potential for accidental release of the contents and exposure to employees and the general public. All Stericycle customers are provided with packaging instructions which describe the packaging, maximum weights, proper sealing/closure of inner bags and outer containers and proper packaging of sharps. These instructions are designed to comply with the packaging requirements of 49 CFR 173.197, which require that waste be packaged in a container that is 1) rigid; 2) leak resistant; 3) impervious to moisture; 4) of sufficient strength to prevent tearing or bursting under normal conditions





### PACKAGING GUIDELINES

All medical waste collected for disposal, must be placed in a corrugated box or reusable container which is lined. (Massachusetts requires two liners per box.) The bag used for this purpose must be of sufficient strength to prevent ripping or tearing per applicable standards. In addition, the bag must be marked according to federal, state and local regulations (i.e., red in color and/or biohazard symbol).

Place all "red bags" into the reusable shipping containers or corrugated boxes.

Sharp materials ("sharps") must be placed in special puncture-resistant containers. Sharps include needles and syringes, scalpel blades, broken glass, culture slides, culture dishes, broken capillary tubes, broken rigid plastic and exposed ends of dental wire. As with other medical waste, sealed containers filled with sharps may be placed in the shipping container. No loose sharps permitted in corrugated boxes or non-approved reusable containers.

Each bag must be sealed/tied. The reusable containers/corrugated boxes must be securely closed.

The outside of each container must bear a label showing your facility's name and address or a specially provided bar code label.

Medical waste does not include chemicals, mercury, solvents, pharmaceuticals (see Waste Acceptance Protocol) or other hazardous wastes. For pathological waste, the preservative agent must be decanted prior to placement in the container.

- Plastic bags which meet the requirements of federal, state and local regulations
- Reusable containers with lids or corrugated boxes which are marked to meet state standards
- Tape
- Special containers for sharps
- Bar code labels (not available in all areas)
- Expertise on Medical Waste Regulations and Management

The above items may be subject to additional charges.



- Generators are responsible for packaging their wastes. Only properly packaged containers will be accepted.
- Each container will be tested for radiation.
   Materials with unacceptable radioactive readings will be rejected and should be disposed of at a properly licensed facility.
