MEMORANDUM

- I On December 29, 2014, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) filed a tariff revision with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) updating its avoided cost tariff, Schedule 37. The Commission suspended operation of the tariffs on February 12, 2015, by Order 01 entered in this docket.
- 2 On May 8, 2015, the Company submitted for filing the Joint Motion of Staff, Pacific Power, and the Renewable Energy Coalition seeking to admit into the record of this proceeding, by agreement, certain documents that were attached to the motion.
