NOTICE SUSPENDING PAYMENT PLAN (Next Installment Payment due by 5 p.m. on October 1, 2020)

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Harrison-Ray Water Company and Harrison Water Company/Kiona, LLC, Dockets UW-180885 and UW-190311 (Consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 26, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 04, Approving Settlement Agreement, in Consolidated Dockets UW-180885 and UW-190311 (Order 04). Among other provisions, Order 04 assessed a \$38,280 penalty against Harrison-Ray Water Company and Harrison Water Company/Kiona, LLC, (Companies), a \$19,140 portion of which was suspended subject to conditions. Order 04 further required the Companies to pay the \$19,140 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in 24 monthly installments, the first of which was due on October 1, 2019. To date, the Companies have made timely payments and are in good standing.

Due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission exercises its discretion to suspend the Company's payment plan for a period of six months. Accordingly, no payments are due until October 1, 2020, at which time the monthly installment plan will resume according to the terms of the Settlement Agreement until the \$19,140 penalty is paid in full. All other terms and conditions of Order 04 remain in full force and effect.
