LINE 610 - ABILITY TO FUNCTION IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

Westgate Communications LLC d/b/a WeavTel (“the Company”) is able to function in emergency situations for both voice and broadband service. The Company has a reasonable amount of backup power to ensure functionality without an external power source. Backup power is provided to Manson Tandem/Earth Station through a fixed generator and batteries that provide it with 72 hours of emergency power. In addition, Stehekin Central Office/Earth Station has at least 72 hours of backup power via mobile generators and fixed batteries.

The Company has the ability to reroute traffic around damaged facilities. It has connectivity with the neighboring telephone exchange of Manson as well as the LATA tandem in Wenatchee which provide diverse options to reroute traffic in an emergency.

The Company is capable of managing traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations and has sufficient switching capabilities to handle such situations. In addition, the Company has developed and trained its staff on network preparedness plans in the event of an emergency.

LINE 1010 – VOICE SERVICES RATE COMPARABILITY

The Wireline Competition Bureau’s 2020 reasonable comparability benchmark for fixed residential local voice services is \$54.76.¹

As of January 1, 2020, the highest rate charged by Westgate Communications LLC d/b/a WeavTel (“the Company”) for fixed residential local voice service was \$25.00. When the federal subscriber line charge (\$6.50) is included, the total rate was \$31.50. Therefore, the Company’s pricing of fixed residential local voice services is less than the reasonable comparability benchmark of \$54.76.

LINE 1030 – BROADBAND SERVICES RATE COMPARABILITY

Westgate Communications LLC d/b/a WeavTel (“the Company”) does not presently have access to terrestrial backhaul in its study area and is compelled to rely exclusively on satellite backhaul. Therefore, under Sec. 54.313(g) of the FCC’s rules, the Company is not expected to offer broadband service that meets the Commission’s standard broadband public interest obligations.

LINE 1210 – TERMS & CONDITIONS OF VOICE TELEPHONY LIFELINE PLANS

Residential customers of Westgate Communications LLC d/b/a WeavTel (“the Company”) who qualify for the Lifeline program receive a federal discount of \$7.25 on local voice telephony service.

In all of the Company’s exchanges, the Lifeline single-line residential rate, including the federal subscriber line charge (“SLC”), is \$24.25 (\$31.50 standard rate - \$7.25 discount).

All single-line residential customers, including Lifeline customers, have an unlimited number of minutes for calls made within their local calling area.

Toll charges for calls outside of the local calling area are determined by the long distance carrier of the customer’s choosing. Customers may elect to subscribe to toll blocking at no charge.

Lifeline program reductions do not apply to additional services such as custom calling features. Lifeline customers may subscribe to these services, where available, at the same rates offered to other customers.
