RE: City of Spokane Valley v. Union Pacific Railroad Company Dockets TR-210809 and TR-210814 (Consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 25, 2021, the City of Spokane Valley (City) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition to Modify Warning Devices at a Highway-Railroad Grade Crossing (Petition) in Docket TR-210809. The City simultaneously filed a formal complaint (Complaint) against Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) in Docket TR-210814. The Complaint seeks a Commission decision assigning ongoing maintenance costs for the grade crossing protective devices to UPRR.
