Background and Summary

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) and Washington State Department of Commerce (Commerce) are developing rules implementing certain sections of the Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA)¹ centered on the implementation of Chapter 19.405 RCW. The Commission filed the CR-101 under Docket UE-210183. Commerce filed its CR-101 under WSR 19-14-050. This workshop allows Commerce, the Commission and interested stakeholders to further discuss interpretations of “use” requirements in RCW 19.405.040(1)(a) in a collaborative environment.

Objectives

1. Gain an understanding of stakeholder proposals regarding the “use” requirement in RCW 19.405.040(1)(a) and gather stakeholder feedback on those proposals
2. Elicit stakeholder suggestions for next steps in the rulemaking on RCW 19.405.040(1)(a).
