BACKGROUND

- On December 4, 2001, Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural or the Company) filed an application for an Order approving a corporate reorganization to create Northwest Natural Holdco, a holding company, to acquire Portland General Electric Company (PGE).
- In addition, NW Natural requested expeditious consideration to issue a decision approving the application by May 15, 2002, citing the unusual circumstances created by the Enron bankruptcy and the benefits of taking advantage of currently low interest rates to secure financing in connection with this transaction.

FINDINGS

3 Northwest Natural Gas Company is a gas company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission. This application for an order approving a corporate reorganization to create Northwest Natural Holdco, a holding company, to acquire Portland General Electric Company, requires analyses and reviews to provide information sufficient to ensure the rights and interests of the public will not be adversely affected. The Commission will enter upon an investigation and set this matter for hearing concerning such reorganization to determine its reasonableness and justness.
